## Up-to-Date Certified Product Information is Now **at Your Fingertips**

Now you can obtain information on any CSA certified product or component using the convenient, easily searchable online listings at [www.csa-international.org](http://www.csa-international.org). Our listings are available to you 24-hours a day and are updated daily to ensure that you always have access to the most current information.

We have prepared this step-by-step guide to our online listings to help you quickly choose the best route to the information you need.

## Getting Started

First log on to [www.csa-international.org](http://www.csa-international.org) and select Certified Product Listings on the home page. At the welcome page, use the link at the bottom of the page to begin your search.

Now you can decide which search option is right for you. The black band near the top of the page offers you two search choices:

- **Search Certification Records** - this page is already open for your use and offers the most detailed search capabilities
- **Search Class Descriptions** - this page allows you to find a particular CSA certification record if you know the applicable class number, can describe the product, or wish to do a keyword search. This search is primarily for use by CSA staff, product manufacturers, or others familiar with CSA's class numbering system.

## Search Certification Records

This option will often provide the quickest route to the desired information because you can locate a certification record using as much, or as little, starting point information as you have available. Supplying information in multiple fields narrows and speeds your search.

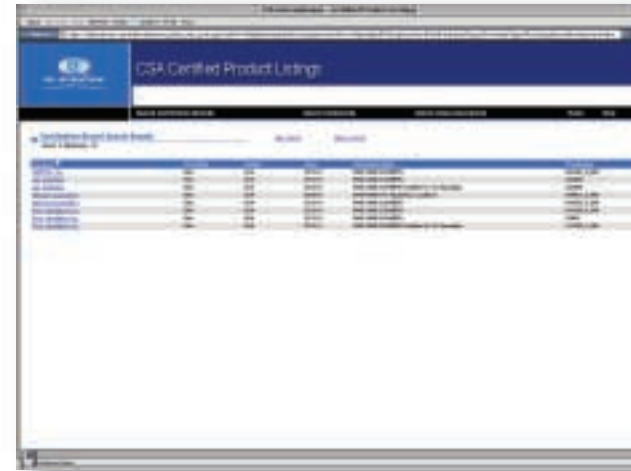
You may enter any combination of information in these fields:

- **Product Directory** - in this field choose the applicable industry sector or product type. If you do not see the listing you are looking for, leave "All Directories" selected.
- **Customer Information** - Indicate the product manufacturer you are looking for. If a manufacturer's name may be listed in different ways, use the most basic name followed by an asterisk (\*) to receive all references to that

manufacturer. (For example, by entering company AAA\* you will receive results for AAA, AAA Corporation, AAA Corp., etc.) You can narrow your search by naming a manufacturer and a location. If you name just a location, and no company, you will get a list of all manufacturers in that location. Be sure to spell out state, province and country names (except "USA").

- **Certification Record Information** - If you already have information about a particular certification record, enter the CSA file number, the product class number, and/or a general class description. Even if you do not have more specific information, you may fill in a key word here to narrow your search.

Once you have filled in as much information as you can, click the **Search** button to view your results.



### Viewing Individual Certification Records

Your search results will be displayed as a table containing a list of companies with associated products and certification record information. The initial table is sorted alphabetically by company name. To focus on specific groups within lengthy results, sort by clicking on the table headings.

To review individual certification records, simply click on the company name to open the record. Select the class number to view a detailed description of the product class.

When you are done reviewing a record, close the window and your original search results will remain open for further review.



## Search by Keyword

If you wish to view records for a particular manufacturer or find a particular model number or model designation, use the keyword search option to quickly narrow your search.
